





#### Meet the Host




Alec Baldwin is the Radio Host of the New York
Philharmonic. Since 1980 Mr. Baldwin has appeared in
numerous productions on stage, in films, and on television.
He has received a Tony nomination (A Streetcar Named Desire,
1992), an Oscar nomination (The Cooler, 2004), and has won
two Emmy Awards, three Golden Globes, and seven
consecutive Screen Actors Guild Awards for Outstanding
Performance by a Male Actor in a Comedy Series for his role
on NBCs 30 Rock. His films include The Hunt for Red October,
Glengarry Glen Ross, Malice, The Edge, It's Complicated, Blue
Josmine, Still Alice, and Mission: Impossible — Rogue Nation,
among many others. Alec Baldwin earned a bachelor of fine
arts degree from New York University's Tisch School of the
Arts in 1994, and received an honorary doctorate in 2010. He
