


A Bit of History: How We Got to Where We Are

Needs of Benzie County Children


- 40% of children NOT kindergarten ready
- 50% of Michigan's 3rd graders NOT reading at grade level
- Brain neuron development from reading
- 37% of Benzie County residents at ALICE or below poverty level






- Love of reading and learning

- Every child receives two bilingual books each year













Mission of the Network






- Parents gain deeper understanding


Brain imaging studies: Increased development in regions of brain


