




NMC - The Big Picture

- 4. Righting the Ship




(1) Refocus

- Reduced Density; Social Distancing; Limiting the Size of Gatherings; Masking; Hand Washing ...
- Positive Cases With Campus Exposure:
 - 29 students
 - 4 employees
- Safety, first; minimize disruption to student learning.

Futures for Frontliners

- Program was designed to <u>reward those serving in</u>
 <u>frontline occupations</u> between April 1 and June 30 who
 have not yet earned an associates or bachelors degree.
- The program pays in-district tuition and fees at a community college for students enrolling at least half-time, to complete an occupational certificate or associates degree program.
- 470 have enrolled at NMC for the Spring semester. Though the state application for eligibility closed on December 31, 2020, eligible applicants have until the Fall 2021 semester to enroll.

Reconnect

- Reconnect is intended for Michigan residents who are <u>25+ years</u> of age, <u>have completed high school but no college degree</u>.
- The program <u>pays in-district tuition and fees at a community</u> <u>college</u> for students enrolling at least half-time, to complete an occupational certificate or associates degree program.
- With nearly 19,000 residents in Northwest Michigan without an associates or bachelors degree, we expect the program to generate a large response.
- 420 applicants to NMC (with enrollment to begin this summer)
